The ISD Employee Health Clinic, operated by Everside Health, serves the Independence School District, providing convenient and affordable access to health care. The Clinic offers acute care, preventive care, chronic condition management, occupational health services, and physical therapy.

Eligibility

Who is eligible to access the services at the ISD Employee Health Clinic?

- All services are available to those members who are enrolled in the District's medical insurance plan, including employees, spouses, dependents over the age of 2, and pre-Medicare retirees.
- Treatment of work-related injuries and occupational health services are available to all District employees regardless of health plan enrollment.

Physical Therapy

Our caring and experienced therapist will get you back doing what you love.

Physical therapy is a service that develops, maintains and restores people's maximum movement and functional ability. Common conditions that are treated include muscle strains and sprains, repetitive use trauma and a variety of orthopedic conditions for those individuals' ages 10+ who are eligible to access the ISD Employee Health Clinic.

What to Expect

Physical therapists can teach patients how to prevent or manage their condition so that they will achieve long-term health benefits. They examine each individual and develop a plan, using treatment techniques to promote the ability to move, reduce pain, restore function, and prevent disability. In addition, physical therapists work with individuals to prevent the loss of mobility before it occurs by developing fitness and wellness-oriented programs for healthier and more active lifestyles.

Types of Treatment

Treatments include, but are not limited to:

- Home exercise program development and education
- Joint and soft tissue mobilization
- Pain management
- Sports related injury rehabilitation
- Strengthening
- Surgical rehabilitation
- Referrals can be made for TMJ and pediatric physical therapy

Cost of Services

The ISD Employee Health Clinic will have the following cost for members enrolled in the District's medical insurance plan. We want you to be prepared that the visit fee will be collected at the time of service via a credit, debit or HSA card. For safety reasons, cash is not accepted.

Visit Fees

- [1] BlueKC medical insurance plan visit maximums apply for physical therapy.
- [2] Cost sharing aligns to BlueKC medical insurance plan amounts after deductible and out of pocket max are met.
- [3] Due to IRS regulations, HSA eligible plan members must pay a minimal visit fee for non-preventive visits, including chronic care or other significant benefits. All fees apply towards deductible and out of pocket maximum. The visit fee will be re-evaluated on an annual basis.

These fees are still considerably less than you would pay for similar services at a physician office, convenience care or urgent care center.

Appointments

A few reminders about appointments:

- Appointments are required. Please schedule an appointment prior to arriving at the ISD Employee Health Clinic.
- To ensure you and your fellow staff members have the shortest wait times and best experience possible, please schedule an appointment prior to arriving by calling (816) 521-5316 [Press 1], or online at https://patientportal.yourhealthstat.com.
- The ISD Employee Health Clinic will do their best to fit you in; however, if a same day appointment is not currently available, the staff will work to get you in as quickly as possible.
- If you have an appointment but are unable to attend, please reschedule or cancel as far in advance as possible (preferably a day prior).
