

# Learning Pods (5-18 years)

**Help families connect with educators to support in-home and small group learning.**

- **Employees post a job** for helping one child or a 'pod' of children with virtual schoolwork.
- **Educators will be badged** as "Ready to Teach", and profiles will further describe their skills and qualifications
- **A new "responsibilities" feature** will allow employees to request help with tutoring or a learning pod
